



MP5™ Chlorine Analyzer Testimonial By: Vinney Guiel - Instrumentation Tech

I have 3 of these Halo MP5 units; 2 are at a wastewater plant, and 1 is installed at a water plant in S. FL. The oldest one is now 2 years old, with NO ISSUES.

I love these units; they have saved us time and money (no reagents), no chemicals going down the drain, and maintenance is a snap, with no tubing or mixing chambers to deal with. They have turned out to be very reliable and easy to use. I have only had to calibrate one of the units about 3 times over 2 years. Very stable and fast response time.

I can't say I dislike anything about these; the only issue you may see is air bubbles in the intake line if you install it inline, but the unit will correct itself by purging the line automatically. Of course, air in the line will affect any analyzer; this one is just a little bit smarter than the others. In a submersion application, it's not even an issue.

The maintenance... It takes me less than 15 minutes to replace the 1-year (Cl₂) maintenance items, which is very easy. They have a parts kit for it with clear instructions. You supply the Philips head screwdriver. The 2-year maintenance replaces the pH sensor, which is also a quick job, less than 15 minutes. Unscrew the sensor and replace it with the new pH sensor. Done.

These units are the way to go for us, especially since they require so much less maintenance and combine 3* parameters in one unit. They are so much better for the environment as well. I am in the process of replacing all our current units (Hach CL-17) with these, and in the future, I see them going county-wide, over 50 units.

These Halogen units exceeded my expectations; they truly are a game changer!

The customer service from Halogen Systems and our local vendor has been awesome; I have spoken to Michael Silveri, the president of the company, on a couple of occasions with questions (I had many questions as well), and each time, I was taken care of quickly and efficiently. They really take care of their customers. The equipment is state of the art, and the customer service has been outstanding. It's hard to find that combination these days.
